### Minimum & Maximum Periods

The minimum period of menstruation is 72 hours (3 days & 3 nights) and the maximum period is 240 hours (10 days & 10 nights).

## Commencement of **Menstruation:**

If a woman's menstruation commences at night or before the Fajr time enters, even for a moment:

- The Fast of the next day cannot be kept and is not valid.
- The Esha and Witr Salaahs cannot be performed and are not valid.

#### Ending of Menstruation before the Maximum Period

If a woman's menstruation ends before the maximum period of 240 hours (after a minimum period of 72 hours) at night or before the Fair time enters, then if the time allows one to perform the Fardh acts of Ghusl and recite the word "Allah" once (approximately 10-15 minutes) before the Fair time enters:

- The Fast of the next day must be kept and is valid.
- The performance of the Esha and Witr Salaahs are compulsory.

If the time does not allow one to perform the Fardh acts of Ghusl and recite the word "Allah" once (approximately 10-15 minutes) before the Fair time enters:

- The Fast of the next day cannot be kept and is not valid.
- The Esha and Witr Salaahs cannot be performed and are not valid.

## Ending of Menstruation at the Maximum Period

If a woman's menstruation ends at the maximum period of 240 hours at night or before the time of Fajr enters, even for a moment:

- The Fast of the next day must be kept and is valid.
- The performance of the Esha and Witr Salaahs are compulsory.

### Ending of Spotting before the Minimum Period

If a woman's spotting ends **before the minimum period** of 72 hours, it is **compulsory (Waajib)** for her to **wait till the end of a Salaah time:** 

- A Make Wudhu and perform the Salaah of the time if there is no spotting.
- B The Fast of the next day must be kept and is valid.

(PART 5)

### Ending of Spotting After the Minimum Period before the Habit

If a woman's spotting ends after the minimum period of 72 hours but before her habit, it is compulsory (Waajib) for her to wait till the end of a Salaah time:

- A Make Ghusl and perform the Salaah of the time if there is no spotting.
- B The Fast of the next day must be kept and is valid.

(PART 6)

Ending of Spotting After the Minimum Period & After the Habit

If a woman's spotting ends after the minimum period of 72 hours but after her habit, it is preferable (Mustahab) for her to wait till the end of a Salaah time:

- Make Ghusl and perform the Salaah of the time if there is no spotting.
- The Fast of the next day must be kept and (B) is valid.
